

2024 GFWC/IOWA FEDERATION OF WOMEN'S CLUBS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Dear Club Presidents,

It is time to begin distributing our statewide scholarship applications. Scholarship awards are based on volunteerism, achievement and financial need respectively.

We have limited funds available, limiting the number of scholarships that can be awarded. Therefore, it is helpful when club members give to the scholarship program from their club budgets. The scholarship committee congratulates the clubs in Iowa for their past contributions and looks forward to their continued generous support this year.

This packet contains the information you need to promote the scholarship program in your local schools. Page 25 in the 2022-2024 BLUEBOOK gives important general information also.

Please take the following steps:

- Along with your club scholarship chairman, carefully read the enclosed information; and then make an extra copy to keep for reference.
- When you have familiarized yourself with these materials, complete the club information at the bottom of the Letter to High School Guidance Counselor and on the back of the GFWC/Iowa Scholarship Application and Campship Application. Please note that the district scholarship chairmen and their names and addresses are included on another page. This information is very important and must be included on the application, so students have the correct mailing addresses. Be sure to include the correct chairman's information. This year the pages are color coded. White pages are for your school packets. The colored pages are for your information and information to be shared with your club members.
- Take the scholarship packet to your high school guidance counselor or administrator and meet with them personally, if possible, to go over the material, answering any questions they may have. You may also take applications to homeschool teachers/parents in your area.
- Please stress the **February 1, 2024,** mailing postmark deadline.
- The packet you take to the high school should include the following (all white pages!):
 - 1. The Guidance Counselor Letter
 - 2. List of GFWC/Iowa Scholarships GFWC/Iowa Scholarship Information Sheet
 - 3. Directions for Student Applicants
 - 4. The GFWC/Iowa Scholarship Application (front and back) and additional Checklist
 - 5. Letter to Music Teacher
 - 6. Music Camp Poster for the Bulletin Board at School
 - 7. Summer Music Campship Application
- Applicants for the GFWC/Iowa 2- or 4-year college scholarships must be sponsored by a GFWC/Iowa club member. If the applicant is unknown to a club member, set up an interview with the applicant either by phone, Zoom or in person, and then prepare a letter of recommendation. Sponsorship letters are no longer required for Campship applicants.

Please ask the students the minimum of the following:

Information on their volunteerism and leadership involvement, their future plans and goals, and if they are currently employed. We want scholarship letters to be consistent from club to club. Students may apply for more than one GFWC/Iowa Scholarship, but they are only eligible to receive one. They should fill out a separate application form for each but may use the same letters of recommendation and other supporting materials or information for all. **Be sure your sponsorship letter includes the name of the sponsoring club.** The GFWC/Iowa 2- and 4-year Scholarship and the Summer Music Campship completed applications must be returned to the appropriate District Scholarship Chairmen as listed on the enclosed District Scholarship Chairman sheet.

• For **music campship applicants**, preference is given to music students that have not previously been awarded a campship. We have also included sample newspaper articles to advertise these scholarships and music campships that can be tailored to your club and sent to your community newspaper. Sample posters are also included to post in the music rooms at the schools to advertise the music campships. No sponsorship letter is required.

Note that the GFWC/Iowa scholarships also include the <u>Phyllis Hughes Memorial Law School</u> and <u>The Clubwoman</u> scholarships. This information should be shared with club members. It may also be shared with area professionals who may be returning to law school.

These additional scholarships **do not** need to be sponsored by a local club, and **the applications should be sent directly to GFWC/Iowa Headquarters**. However, *The Clubwoman* scholarship must include a letter from her club president to acknowledge her club membership. The state scholarship chairman sends an application for the law school scholarship to the University of Iowa, Drake University Law Schools in Iowa, and Marquette University Law School in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, in compliance with stipulations of the Phyllis Hughes estate. Separate application forms are included in the packet for the *Phyllis Hughes Memorial*, a law school scholarship, and *The Clubwoman* scholarship, for club members.

Your district scholarship chairman will be glad to help you with any questions. Scholarship judging will take place in March, and the applicants will be notified by email immediately following. Scholarship checks will be sent to the student made out to the student <u>AFTER</u> the student is enrolled in the fall 2024 term and sends proof of registration to GFWC/IOWA Headquarters. Unless specified, male and female students are eligible.

Thank you for your ongoing support of this important program.

Dear Club President,

Each year GFWC/Iowa sponsors several music campship awards to deserving 8-12 grade students (students that will have graduated from the 7th grade). These awards may be applied toward tuition, room and board and individual lessons at a summer music camp within Iowa. Campships are awarded in the amount of the camp cost, up to \$400. Award recipients are responsible for the balance of their costs.

Because of the generous gift from the E. Lucille Miller estate and club donations, we can award more music campships annually. With dedication on the part of our GFWC/Iowa members to promote this program, more students can attend the summer music campships.

Be sure to fill in the name of your club, club's contact name, mailing address, email address and phone number. Also, fill in the name, mailing address, email address, and phone number of your district scholarship chairman on the Music Campship Application form.

Give a copy to the 8-12 grade school instrumental and vocal music educators at your school and private music teachers that you know in your community. Make as many copies as needed. We have enclosed a sample poster to use in the music classrooms. Feel free to use this one or create your own.

Your club and contact info still need to be listed on the application as the sponsoring club. Club sponsorship letters are no longer needed. Campship applications should be sent directly to the district chairman.

Your district scholarship chairman (must be listed on the bottom of the Music Campship Application form) will be glad to help you with any questions. Judging will take place in March, and applicants will be notified immediately via email. Preference will be given to those students who have not previously received a GFWC/Iowa Music Campship. Music camp checks will be mailed to the student after proof of registration is mailed to GFWC/Iowa Headquarters. This should be done early in June.

GFWC/Iowa Scholarships Available – Application Deadline February 1, 2024

The Iowa General Federation of Women's Clubs (GFWC) is the proud sponsor of a scholarship program unique to Iowa. Each year, thousands of dollars are awarded to graduating high school seniors who will be attending post-secondary schools. Scholarship awards are based primarily on volunteerism, achievement and, in some cases, field of study. Unless specified, both males and females are eligible to apply. Students planning to attend two-year community college and vocational schools are competing for \$500 scholarships. Those students attending four-year colleges are competing for \$1,000 scholarships.

Additional designated scholarships are available for those studying music and law. Two \$1,000 music scholarships will be awarded through a generous donation made by the estate of E Lucille Miller. One student studying law will be awarded a \$1,000 Phyllis Hughes Memorial scholarship. Preference is given for a law student attending Marquette University. If there is not an lowa native student attending Marquette (occurs frequently), the scholarship is awarded to a law student at the University of Iowa or Drake University.

Women that are members of a GFWC club are also eligible to apply for a \$500 Clubwoman scholarship. This scholarship can be applied toward a four-year college, a graduate degree or professional licensure for their occupation.

GFWC/Iowa Scholarship Information Sheet Application Deadline- February 1, 2024

The GFWC/Iowa Scholarship Committee administers a number of scholarships to Iowa students in Iowa colleges and universities. This money is paid to the student by check, after she/he has provided registration documentation to the GFWC/Iowa State Headquarters for the fall term in the year the scholarship is awarded. The number of each scholarship awarded is determined by the amount of money contributed by clubs, proceeds from special fund-raising projects and interest from investments on memorial scholarships. GFWC/Iowa scholarship awards are based on volunteerism, achievement and financial need.

GFWC/Iowa Scholarships 2024

1.	E. Lucille Miller Memorial Music Scholarship (College Undergraduate)	\$1,000	Open to a graduating high school senior majoring in Music at an accredited four-year Iowa college or university.
2.	GFWC/Iowa Scholarship (College Undergraduate) (Multiple to be Awarded)	\$1,000	Open to a graduating high school senior enrolled in Undergraduate studies attending an accredited four-year Iowa college or university.
3.	Community College Scholarship (Multiple to be Awarded)	\$500	Open to a graduating high school senior enrolled in a 2-year accredited Iowa community college/technical school or other comparable accreditation/certification programs.
4.	Clubwoman Scholarship (College Undergraduate or College Graduate for a Women's Club Member)	\$500	Open to a GFWC/Iowa Clubwoman with an active membership status for undergraduate study, graduate study, or CEUs.
5.	Phyllis Hughes Memorial Scholarship (Law School)	\$1,000	Open to a woman from Iowa to study law at the University of Iowa, Drake University or with preference given for attendance at Marquette University in Wisconsin.



Directions for Student Applicants

Dear Student:

Applicants should collect all necessary materials, organize them in order of the checklist found on the second page of the application, and mail ALL pages of the scholarship application and required information in one envelope to the DISTRICT CHAIRMAN as written on the second page of the scholarship application. The district chairman's name and address should already be completed for you.

This year you may apply for the first three scholarships listed, as long as you are otherwise eligible. You may apply for more than one scholarship; however, you are only eligible to receive one. You must fill out a separate application form for each scholarship but may use the same letters of recommendation.

One page essay "How my involvement in my community has impacted my life." Include any special circumstances that make the scholarship beneficial for you.

GFWC/Iowa scholarship awards are based on volunteerism, achievement and financial need, in that order. All information is confidential.

Please remember that a late or incomplete application will be rejected. CHECK ALL MATERIAL CAREFULLY. <u>February 1, 2024</u>, is the <u>POSTMARK DEADLINE</u>. Please use the correct amount of postage; or the post office may return your packet, resulting in a missed deadline. *Students will receive judging results via email after March 15th*.
